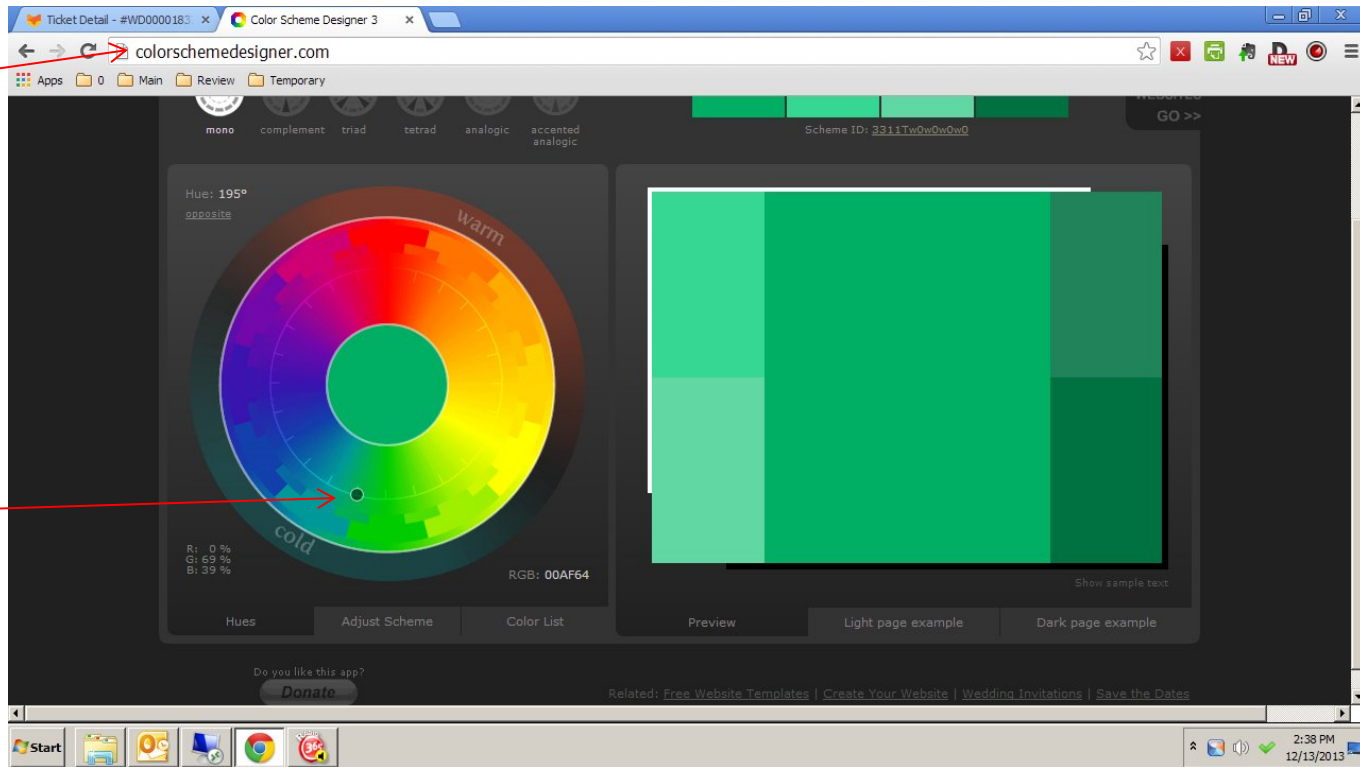
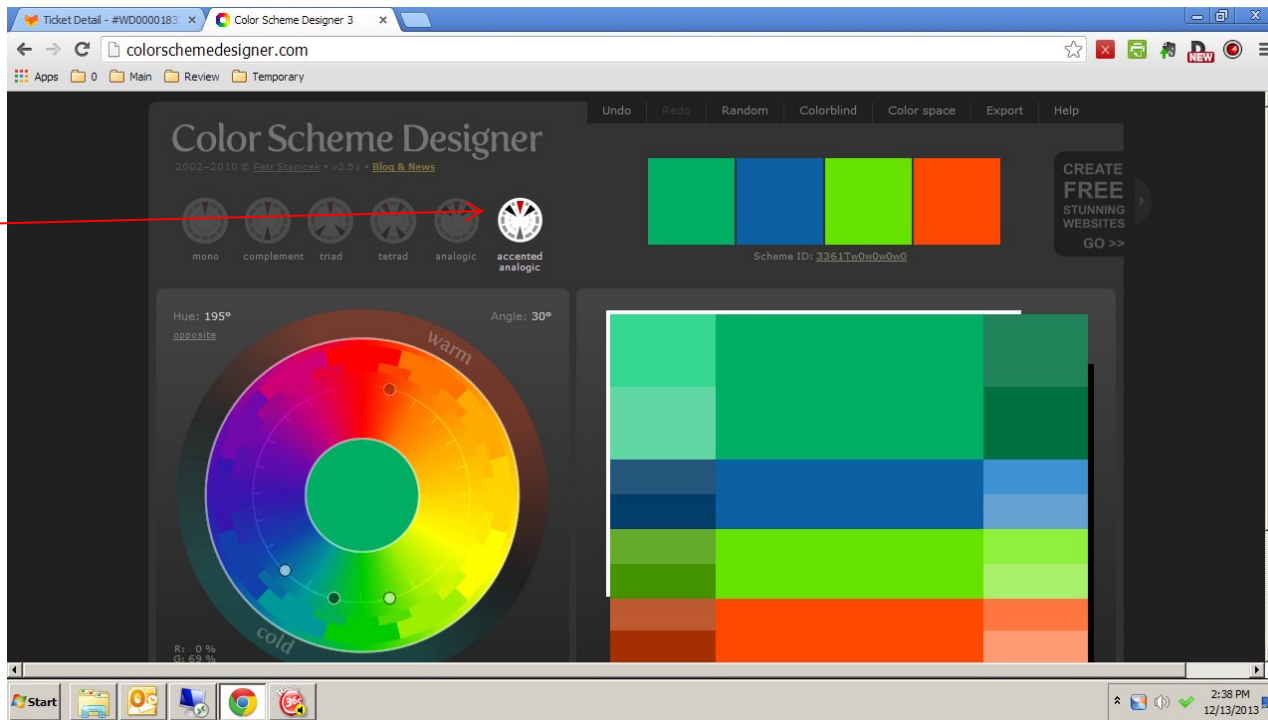


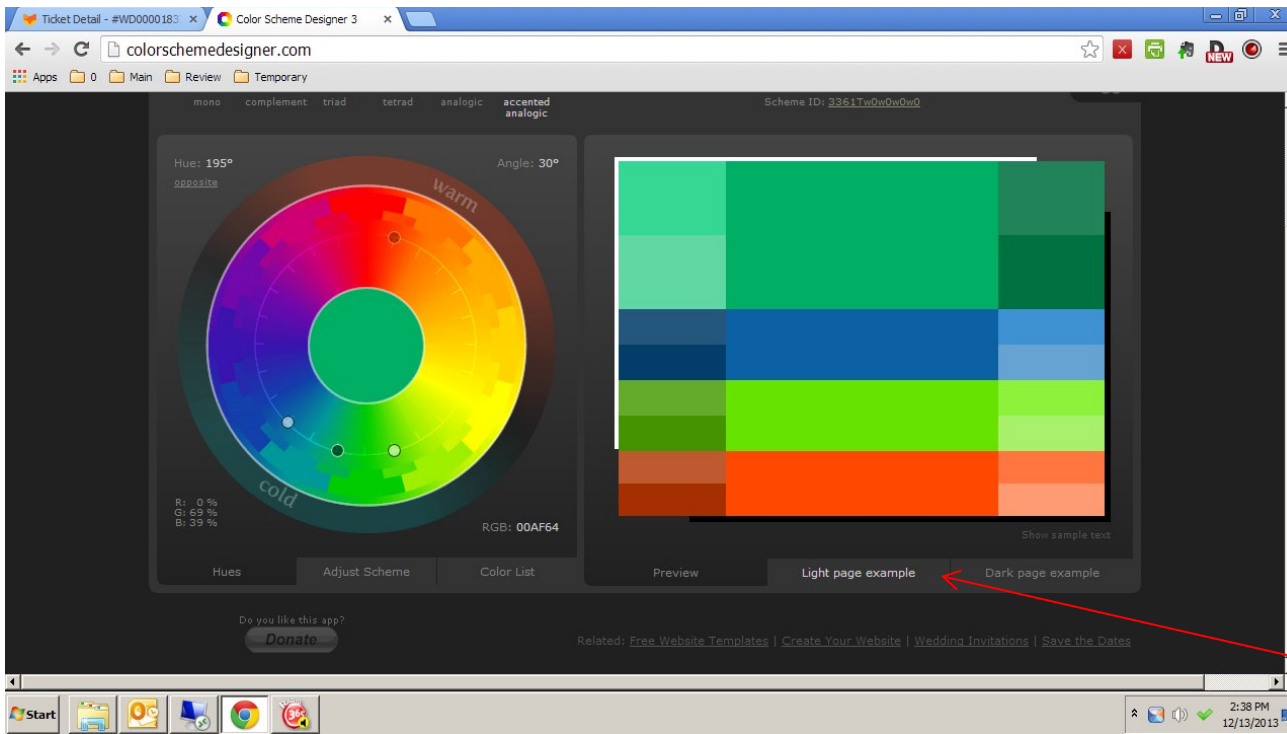
Creating Website Color Schemes



Open a browser window and type <http://colorschemedesigner.com/> in the URL block. Click on the small dot in the color wheel and drag it around the wheel until it rests on the primary color for your web design.



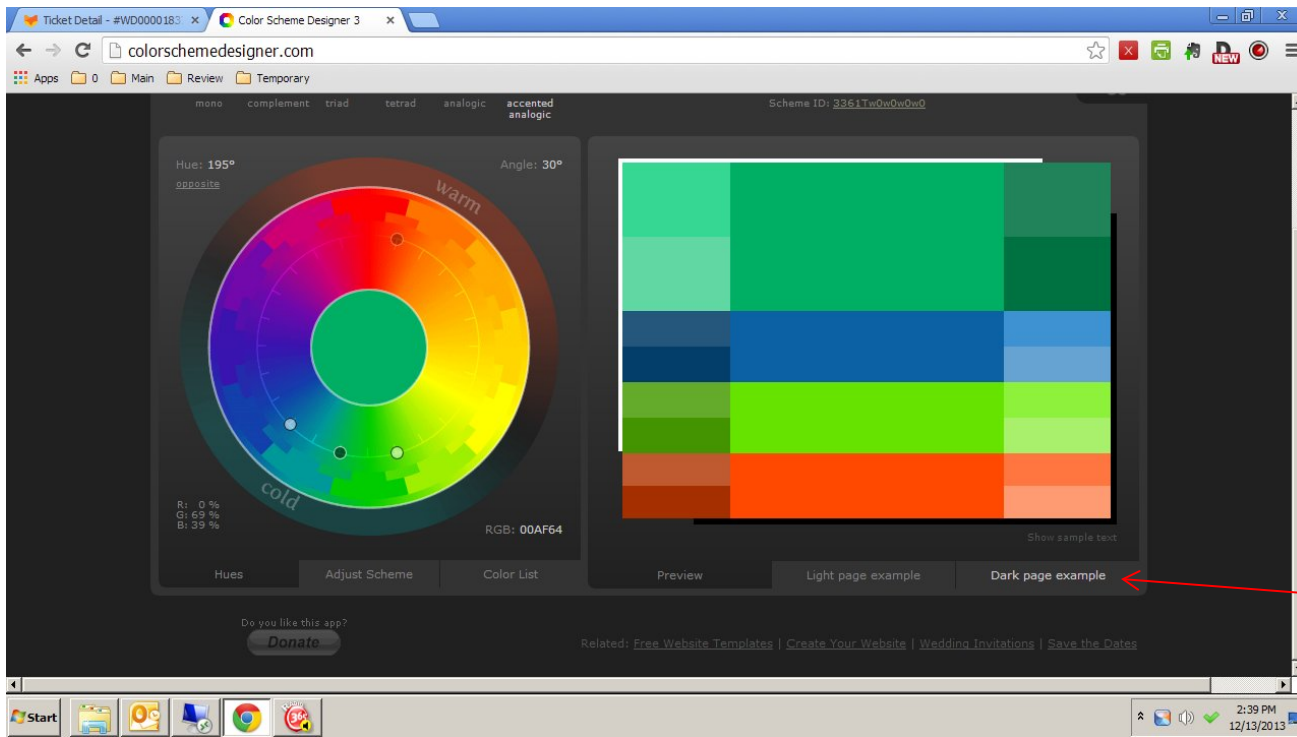
Once the primary web design color is chosen, click on the small wheel icon titled “accented analogic.” This will display all of the complimentary colors that will highlight the primary design color.



To see what a lighter color web design would look like, click on the bottom link “Light page example.”



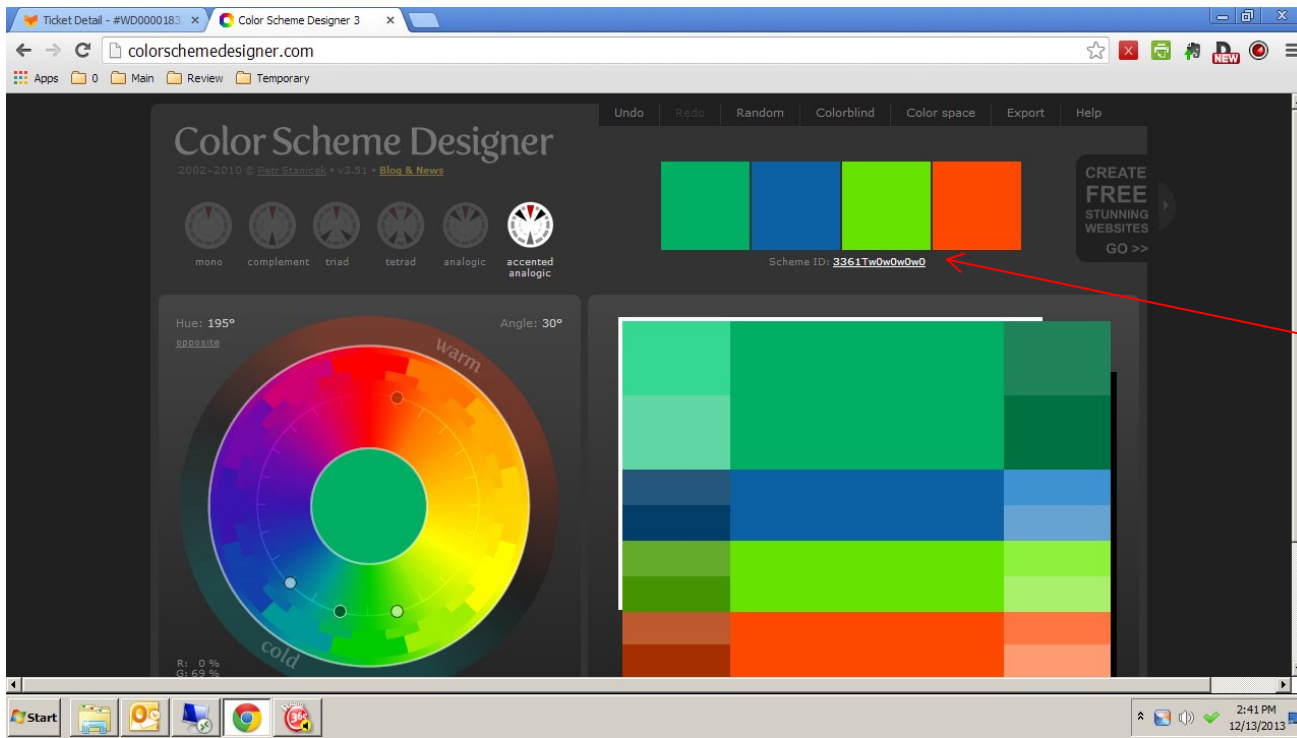
A sample web page will be presented with the dominant primary color accented by the additional complimentary colors.



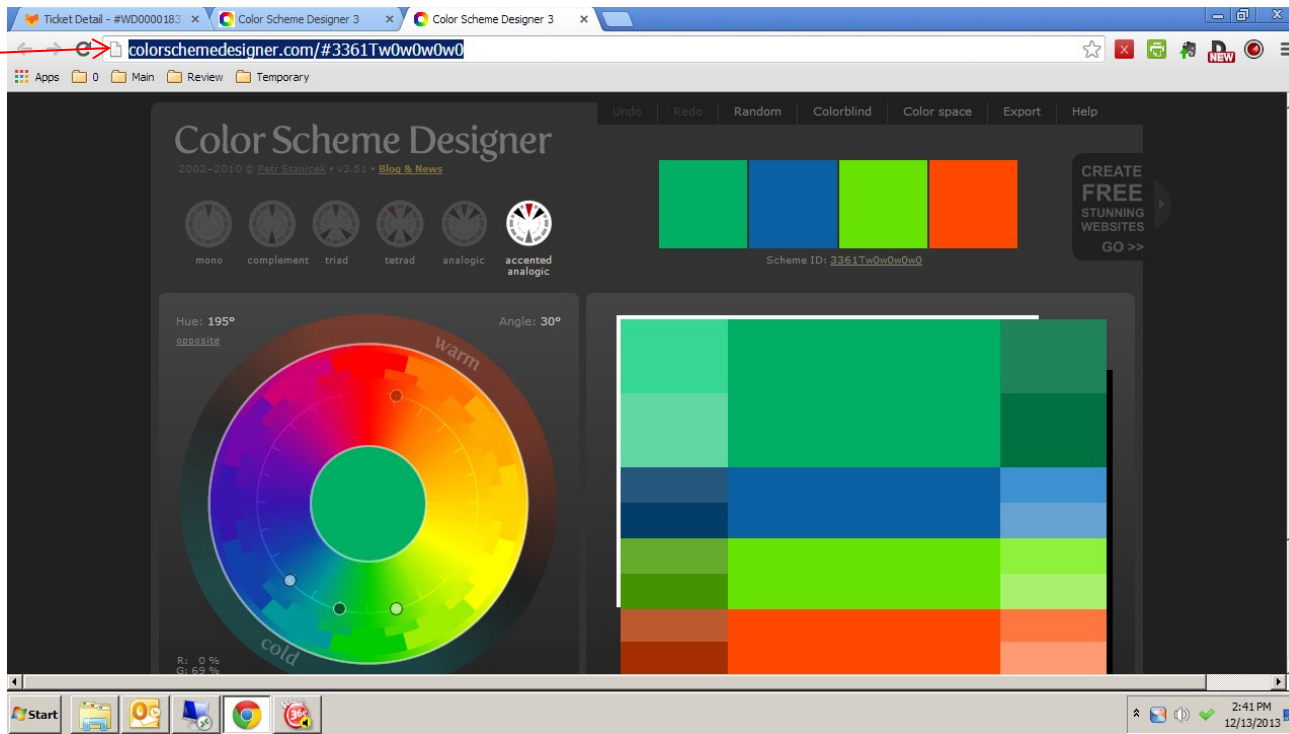
For a dark website sample, click on the “Dark page example” link.



A dark website design sample will be displayed. Repeat the above steps until you have a set of complimenting colors that are satisfactory.



Once a set of complimentary colors is found, click on the link “Scheme ID:” That link will open a new window with all of the information needed to recreate the chosen color scheme.



Highlight the URL with the mouse. Hold down the <Ctrl> key and press the c key. Go to the email/ticket being used to track your web design and position the cursor where you would like to paste the web page URL. Now Hold down the <Ctrl> key and press the v key. The URL should appear in the email/ticket. The URL will provide all the information we need to create your mockups using the chosen color scheme(s). Please feel free to present us with more than one set of colors/URLs.
