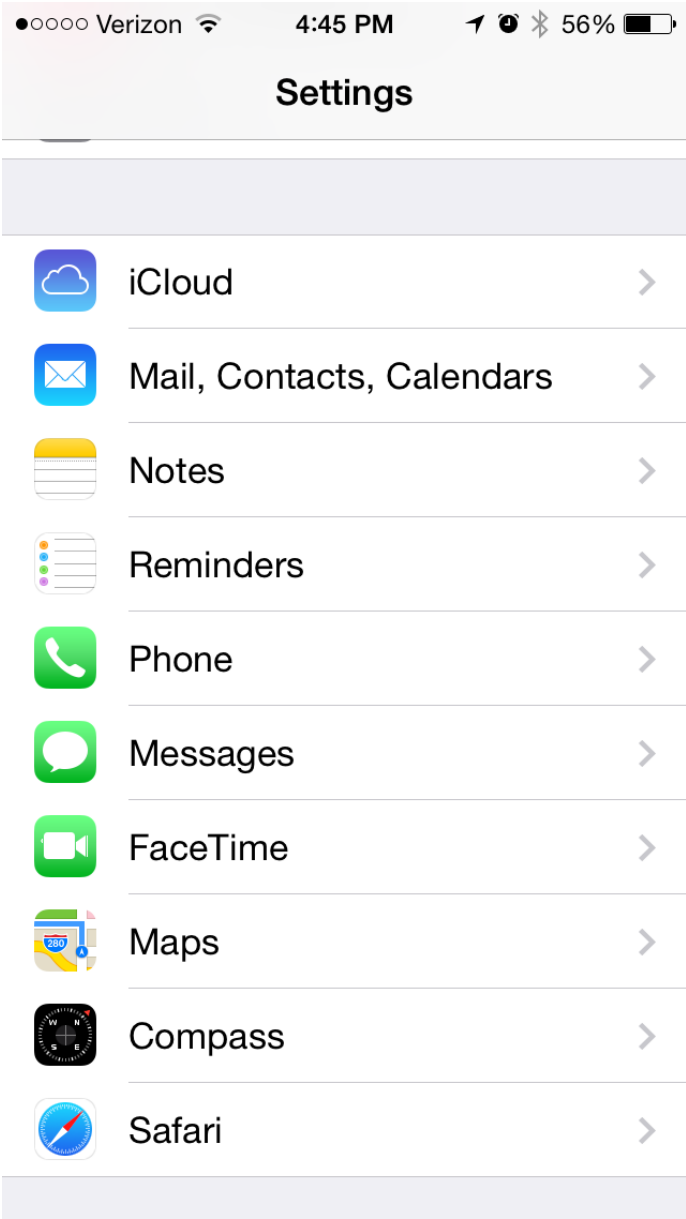


Please be advised that there are many brands of cell phones, many different operating systems and many versions of those operating systems. It is impossible to support Email on a cell phone remotely.

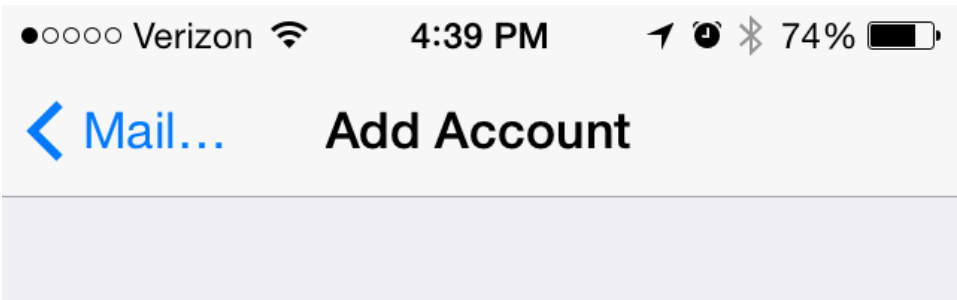

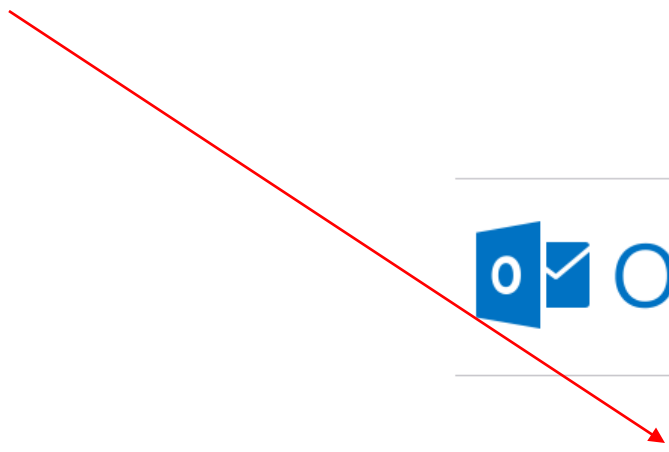
